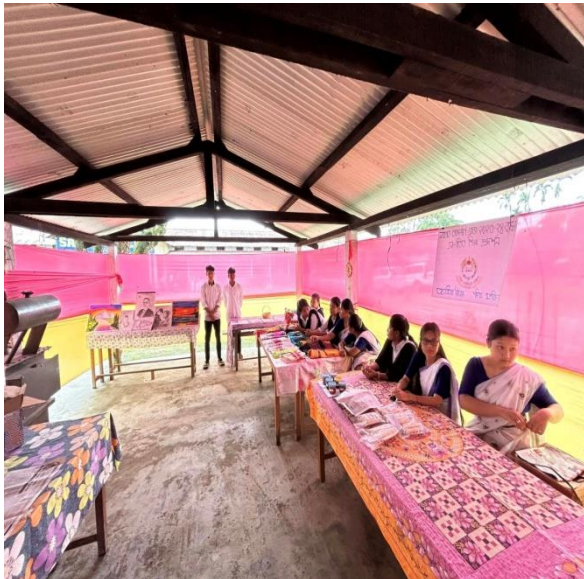


**Handicrafts exhibition on initiative of Utkarsh-The Personality Development Cell,

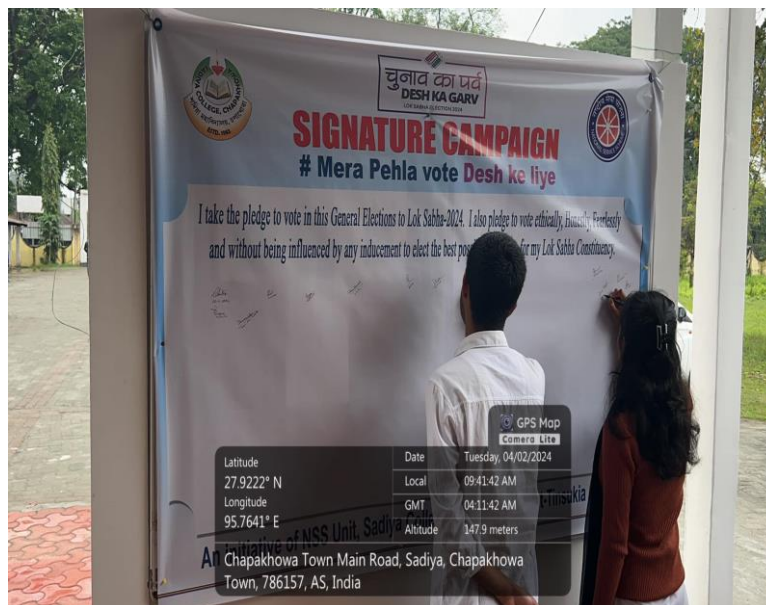

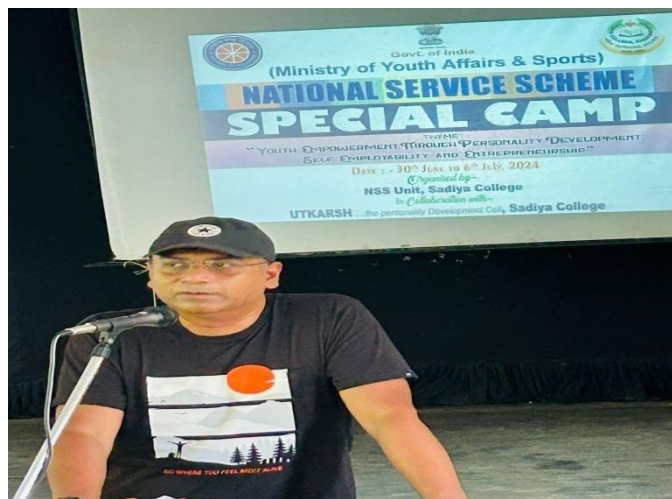
